## Residency Fee & Invoicing

Artists will receive a **residency fee** of:

- \$1,500 for the development week  
To be paid on receipt of invoice no earlier than two weeks prior to the start date.

### The Mullins Theatre

Approx. 10m x 5.2m

Mirrors, blackout curtains, sprung floor

Adjacent green room and kitchen facilities

### House Guidelines:

The Q Theatre Company is located at The Joan Sutherland Performing Arts Centre, 597 High Street, Penrith, 2750

- Train: 3-minute walk from Penrith Station
- Bus: Local and regional routes stop at Penrith Plaza
- Parking: Paid and free options nearby
